
## **Problem 100227**

North leads a  $\heartsuit$ T against your  $6 \heartsuit$  contract. You play ace from dummy and South follows. How would you play this contract?

## 100227.2

This is a problem from the match I played against Hsinchu Tsinghua University in September, 2008.



The bidding goes:

West	North	East	South
		$1\diamondsuit$	Pass
$1 \heartsuit$	$1\spadesuit$	$4 \heartsuit$	Pass
4NT	Pass	5♣	Pass
$6 \heartsuit$	Pass	Pass	Pass

North leads  $\spadesuit A$  and continues another  $\spadesuit$ . You discard a diamond under  $\spadesuit K$  and play  $\heartsuit A$  from dummy. Surprisingly North fails to follow a heart. How would you play this contract?
