



North opens 1NT and South jumps to $4\spadesuit$. Partner leads $\heartsuit A$ and $\heartsuit 7$ to your $\heartsuit 9$. You cash $\heartsuit K$ and declarer ruff with a small spade. Then he plays $\spadesuit A$, K. Partner follows $\spadesuit 5,7$. You discard a small diamond on the second round. Now South plays $\spadesuit J$ to parnter's $\spadesuit Q$ and dummy's $\clubsuit 5$, what now?

South plays $4\heartsuit$ after $1\heartsuit-3\heartsuit-4\heartsuit$ auction. The first several rounds were: $(W)\diamondsuit Q-\diamondsuit K-\diamondsuit 2-\diamondsuit 7$, $(N)\heartsuit Q-\heartsuit 3-\heartsuit 4-\heartsuit K$, $(W)\diamondsuit T-\diamondsuit 5-\diamondsuit 9-\diamondsuit A$, $(S)\heartsuit 6-\heartsuit 9-\heartsuit J-\heartsuit 5$, $(N)\diamondsuit 5-\diamondsuit 8-\heartsuit 7-\diamondsuit 3$. Then south plays A and A to A to A KQ, pitching a spade from his hand. Now he leads A from dummy, what now?
